

Under the able guidance of The Secretary, MSDE Shri Rajesh Aggarwal ji and Special Secretary Shri Atul Kumar Tiwari ji, a workshop on Awareness of Apprenticeship Reforms was organized by RDSDE Delhi NCR on 5th and 6th May 2022 at Lemon Tree, Sector 60, Gurgaon.



The day 1 was inaugurated at 10.00 am. Shri Director K Sreenivasa Rao, Shri Salil Lal Vice President and Shri Saurab Pathak GM from Maruti Suzuki India Pvt Ltd have lighted the lamp and declared the event inaugurated.



36 Participants from 12 Establishments, 11 State Apprenticeship Advisors of States in Northern Region, 15 Assistant Apprenticeship Advisors, 19 from Sector Skill Councils, 12 from Regional Directorate of Skill Development and Entrepreneurships, 10 participants from Third Party Aggregators all together a Total of 113 participants attended the workshop.



The dissemination of the OMs on Apprenticeship Reforms were done through lectures delivered by Shri Ajay Bhagat Deputy Director, Shri Abhishek NSDC, Shri Ramesh Babu Deputy director, Shri Pranil NSDC, Miss Feba NSDC, Miss Anisha NSDC and Miss Navpreet NSDC. They made the participants aware of the recent Reforms being carried by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship in the implementation of Apprenticeship scheme in the Country. They also clarified the doubts raised by the participants on various issues.

Mr Praveen Manikpuri Independent Consultant spoke and interacted with the participants on Rules and Acts of Apprenticeship elaborately.

In addition, The team from Board of Apprenticeship Training including Shri V S Pandey Deputy Director, Shri Vivek Kumar Assistant Director and Shri Sandeep Kumar Assistant Director described the Salient features of National Apprenticeship Training Scheme of Ministry of Education.

All the participants were made aware of the further rules simplification required. Accordingly their views on future requirements in Rules and Acts as well as portal development and process management were obtained. These suggestions are recorded for the MSDE Apprenticeship division to follow up on the same.

Covid protocol was followed on both the days and the participants were given by RDSDE Delhi NCR, a Sanitizer and Mask kit along with the Jute folder and writing materials.
